

Supply List & Advanced Prep Introduction to Thread Painting

IF NOT USING KIT:

- Flower panel or larger scale focus fabric
- Background fabric at least 2" bigger than your focus piece
- 1 yard totally stable
- 9" x 12" piece or larger of muslin fabric for practice
- 3/4 yard or more of Thermolam Plus Batting (non-fusible)
- Border/Binding/Backing fabric (yardage depends on size of your desired project)

Supplies

- Sewing machine in good working order
- Free motion or darning foot (one that will allow use of the zig-zag stitch)
- Top thread- The more the merrier!, The more shades you bring the more fun it is..
- Bobbin thread and extra bobbins on hand,
- Needles- I like to use Size 80 or 90 quilting topstitch embroidery or Microtex sharp needles,
- Small sharp scissors
- Basting Spray
- Iron/pressing surface

Optional Supplies

- Hoop (Quilt Halo is my all-time favorite!),
- Quilting gloves, Book:
- Thread Magic Garden by Ellen Anne Eddy,
- Drop in table or Extension table for your sewing machine to give you a large flat surface for working,
